Teaching and Workshop Evaluations

At the close of the Winterim Workshop, students were invited to complete an online Teaching and Workshop Evaluation to assess their experience. The 18-question evaluation was modeled after the course evaluations but included specific questions relevant to the workshop. Out of the 20 students who received the evaluation link, 19 responded. Most questions asked students to rate each area from 1 to 7. When averaged, the overall evaluation of the workshop was a 6.37, and the overall evaluation of the

instructor was a 6.74. Also notable, 100% of respondents said they would recommend the workshop to other Lewis & Clark students. Full results may be viewed in the end of this report.
