1. Women's Tennis Capture 2016 Northwest Conference Title:

In April, the L&C women's tennis team was named the Northwest Conference Champions after a 12-0 season. The title is the first for the Pioneers since Lewis & Clark won nine straight Women's Conference of Independent Colleges titles from 1971-1979.

2. Sports Information & Website:

Last spring we officially hired, Ryan Goff as our new Director of Athletics Communication to replace the vacant Sports Information Director position.
