Come Prepared

- Install an up-to-date antivirus software. You can download Symantec for free from the IT website.
- Update software on your computer to ensure your operating system is running smoothly.
- Bring OS and software installation disks with you, or backup these files to a flash drive.
- Back up your computer regularly. Avoid consequences of hard drive failure by backing files up to Google Drive, or storing them on a flash drive or external hard drive.

Get Online

- Lewis and Clark students can access the wifi from almost anywhere on campus by registering devices through Safeconnect.
- Operating Systems need to be up to date with antivirus software installed.
- Getting connected:
 - Connect to "LC Wireless" and navigate to the Lewis and Clark homepage.
 - You will be redirected to the Network Registration page. Follow instructions to install XpressConnect software.
 - After opening and running the software, you will be given unrestricted access to "LC Secure" on your device.
- You can fill out the request form on the IT website if you'd like to activate your ethernet ports (ideal for desktop computers and gaming consoles).
