He will be encouraged to follow up with the theatre department about possible collaboration.
- 4. General Education: Faculty Council discussed process. Dr. Kugler proposed that after the discussion trickles down to the departments, he would like to see a discussion at the divisional level before moving forward. Dr. Bekar wants to see if there is divisional interest

at this time. He doesn't see a log of energy in the social sciences. Dr. Kugler suggested asking departments how they see themselves in contributions to the College and asking them to produce a two-three page self study.
