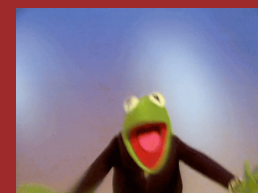

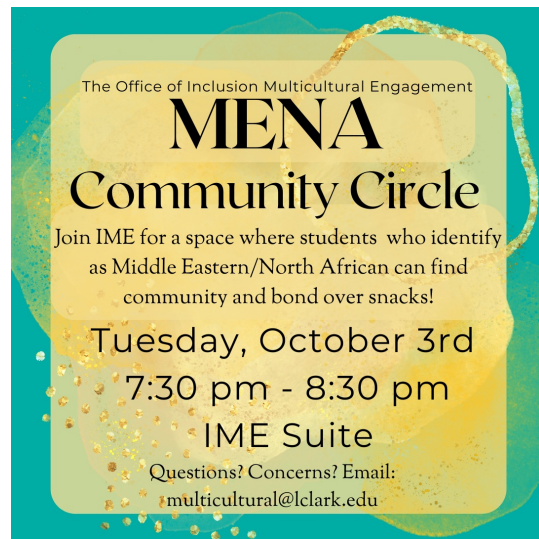

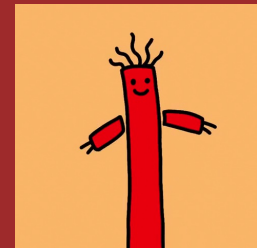
Help host an IME Community Circle!

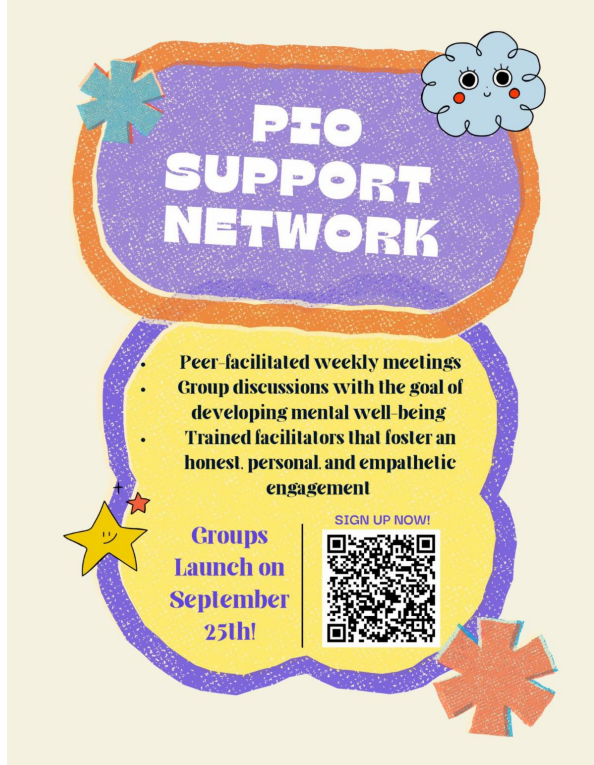
Pio Support Network weekly groups are live!
