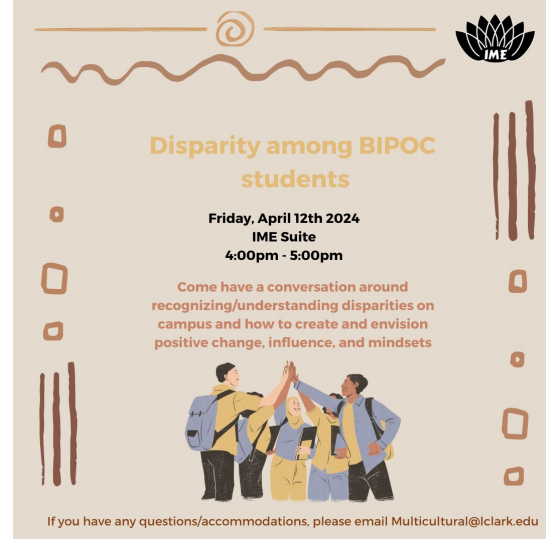
Wokeshop: Conversation on Disparities on Campus

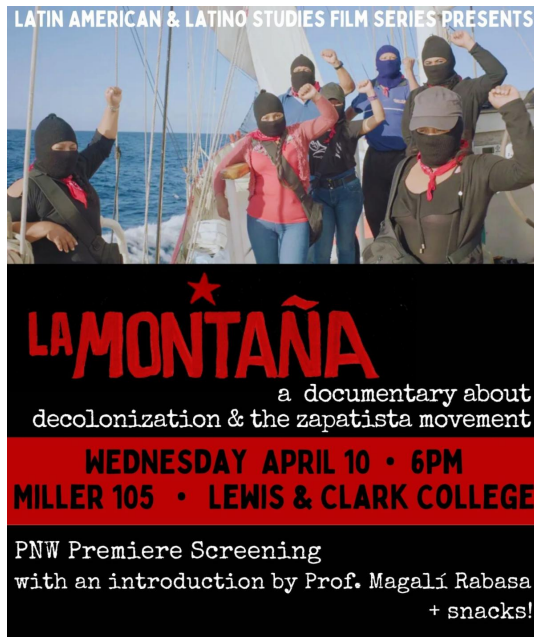
