ELIGIBILITY

- A citizen or national of the United States
- An undergraduate student in good standing at an accredited institution of higher education in the United States (including both two-year and four-year institutions);
- Receiving a Federal Pell Grant during the time of application or provide proof that they will be receiving a Pell Grant during the term of their study abroad program or internship
- In the process of applying to, or accepted to, a credit-bearing study abroad or internship program. Proof of program acceptance is required prior to award disbursement
- Applying for credit-bearing study abroad programs in a country or location with an overall Travel Advisory Level 1 or 2, according to the <u>U.S.</u> <u>Department of State's Travel</u> <u>Advisory System</u>

TIPS & TRICKS

- Write a rough draft without worrying about grammar and organization.
 Get all your thoughts and ideas out there at first and it can all be revised later.
- When answering the application questions you're telling a story and painting a picture of who you are with each question. Make sure all your questions have a relationship with one another in some way.
- Get started on the application draft early (preferably begin during the school breaks)
- Meet with Blythe Knott and/or someone in the overseas office to help you revise your application
- Make sure to grammar and spell check before turning it in so they know that you put thought and care into your application.
