Send your updated official transcript and verified test scores (if needed) to the Office of Admissions.

July

Process student and parent loans and begin monthly payment plan (if applicable).

By August 6

Settle your fall semester student account.

Late March

We will begin providing financial aid award notifications to students who filed the CSS Profile and FAFSA by our priority date of 11:59 p.m. Pacific time on March 1.

Mid-May

Information about New Student Orientation, advising, and registration becomes available and will be mailed to you upon receipt of your nonrefundable deposit.

Second week of July

You should receive an e-bill for the fall semester.
