Regular Decision Admitted Students

May 1 at 11:59 p.m. Pacific time Postmark deadline for submitting your nonrefundable deposit.

All Admitted Students

May 1 at 11:59 p.m. Pacific time Postmark deadline for submitting your residence hall contract for priority consideration of your housing preferences.

Mid-May We will mail you information about New Student Orientation, advising, and registration.

July 1 Deadline for sending your final high school transcript and verified test scores (if needed) to the Office of Admissions.

July Process student and parent loans and begin monthly payment plan (if applicable).

Second week of July You should receive an e-bill for the fall semester.
