

Renewable Energy Intern (Facilities Service)

- Purpose:** To coordinate, promote and support the proper use of the Green Energy Fee and sustainability initiatives broadly.
- Role:** Serve as a liaison in the Student Senate and report renewable energy initiatives to the Associate Students of Lewis & Clark; gain insight from student representatives.
- Be a resource for students looking to pursue sustainable thought or projects and act as a coordinator between individuals and/or clubs.
- Duties:** Serve as the primary point of contact for students wishing to understand, pursue or engage in renewable energy initiatives.
- Assist students in developing Green Fee Fund proposals; develop an ongoing process for education and outreach.
- Publicize the events, projects, and activities of the Green Energy Fee Committee and clearly relay information to the community, as needed.
- Meet regularly with the leaders of “green” student organizations to remain aware of each organization’s goals and projects, as needed.
- Meet regularly with the Sustainability Manager and serve as a liaison on the Sustainability Council, attending meetings when appropriate.
- Actively engage in the promotion of sustainability on campus through participation in academic, organizational, or administrative sustainability initiatives.
- Research sustainable ideas and practices that could be implemented at Lewis & Clark.
- Requirements:** Strong communications, writing, and organizational skills
- Solid understanding of renewable energy issues, markets (including renewable energy certificates), campus commitments and previous efforts.
- Must be available to work for Fall and Spring semester.
- Preferred Qualities:** Willingness to and affinity for interacting with multiple student groups.
- Understanding of existing sustainability-related and renewable energy programming; including existing clubs, committees, and existing and potential resources.
- High-level attention to detail, well-organized
- Compensation:** Double Room rate credit to your student account for on-campus housing; must live on-campus all year.
