## ESSAY QUESTIONS (250 WORDS MAXIMUM PER QUESTION)

- 1. Why are you applying to this particular program? How will your participation contribute to the program? How does this program contribute to your academic career at Lewis & Clark College? How does this program contribute to your major curriculum?
  - **1b**. (*Programs with foreign languages only*): List the courses you've taken and the experiences you've had using a foreign language. Be specific as to what languages; where you studied and for how long; degree of skill in reading, writing, and speaking. If your program has a language requirement, please mention your plans for fulfilling it.
- 2. Describe how you spend your leisure time; list any interests, hobbies, activities, etc.
- 3. What evidence can you give of your ability to pursue the demands of this program in regards to initiative, persistence, and self-discipline? Cite any work, volunteer, and co-curricular experience.
- **4.** What experiences have you had in living or working with people from different cultural backgrounds? What other states or countries have you traveled/lived in, which have significantly impacted who you are?
- 5. What other parts of your character do people discover as they get to know you better? How do you respond to misunderstanding, frustration, and/or failure to achieve a specific goal? You may wish to describe a situation in which you experienced these feelings and discuss your methods of coping.
