Year-to-Date Fundraising Highlights:

- More than 36 seniors have made their senior gift as compared to 28 last year.
- Pioneers for Pioneers has seen an 87 percent increase in student dollars from FY16.
- Email has seen a 37 percent increase in dollars raised.
- Recurring (open ended, monthly) gifts from alumni have increased 69 percent from FY16.
- CAS alumni have increased dollars raised by 20 percent from FY16 and 27 percent from FY15.
- Reunion Giving program has raised \$233,674 from 375 donors. Class of '82 has a very small lead over '72 and '67 in participation, and the Class of '72 leads in dollars raised.

- \$18,335 in challenge dollars remain to be utilized in FY17.

Spring Campaigns

March 15, 2017 Lewis & Clark Day of Giving

The primary purpose for the LC Day of Giving is to engage LC students, alumni, parents, faculty, and staff through multi-channel communication and on-campus activities to raise dollars and donors for the college. The goal is to raise 2,000 parent, alumni, student, faculty, and staff gifts in 24-hours. At this time we have challenge funds from a trustee and are confirming additional challenge dollars for a total of \$125,000. On campus challenges aim to increase giving among students, faculty, and staff and total approximately \$17,000 in additional funds. This year, Day of Giving will be an institution-wide effort including the Graduate and Law schools.
