Lewis & Clark College supports the use of preferred names for students, while maintaining the official, legal name required for academic records and data integrity. The College also supports the use of preferred pronouns, though gender, pronoun and legal sex are not displayed on rosters or routine academic records such as transcripts or verifications.¹
