2. Prospective Student-Athlete Weekend Event

This September we welcomed over 50 prospective student-athletes and their families to campus for the opportunity to get an in depth look at life as a student-athlete at Lewis & Clark College. During their time on campus they met with coaches and professors as well as sat in on classes, ate in the dining hall and heard from current student-athletes.

The athletics department bring value to the institution in many ways, which includes the recruitment and retention of student-athletes.

- Athletics brings approximately 20% of the entering class at a higher yield rate and lower discount rate.
- This year that meant 103 students at a yield of 22% rate. We also enrolled 7 transfer students.
- Of the 103 incoming first year student-athletes, 42 are students of colors or first-generation.
- Our student-athlete GPA this past year was 3.2 and all teams (with the exception of men's golf) was above a 3.0.
- The athletics department graduates student at a higher rate than students generally.
