

# New Student Technology Guide

## Come Prepared

- **Install an up-to-date antivirus software.** You can download Symantec for free from the IT website.
- **Update software on your computer** to ensure your operating system is running smoothly.
- **Bring OS and software installation disks** with you, or backup these files to a flash drive.
- **Back up your computer regularly.** Avoid consequences of hard drive failure by backing files up to Google Drive, or storing them on a flash drive or external hard drive.

## Get Online

- Lewis and Clark students can access the wifi from almost anywhere on campus by registering devices through Safeconnect.
- Operating Systems need to be up to date with antivirus software installed.
- Getting connected:
  - Connect to “LC Wireless” and navigate to the Lewis and Clark homepage.
  - You will be redirected to the Network Registration page. Follow instructions to install AutoConnect software.
  - After opening and running the software, you will be given unrestricted access to “LC Secure” on your device.
- You can fill out the request form on the IT website if you’d like to activate your ethernet ports (ideal for desktop computers and gaming consoles).

- Your LEmail account is functionally a Google account, which means that you have access to Google’s great suite of educational tools.
- Your .edu email address also entitles you to enumerable special memberships, access priveledges, and discounts.
- Already have a personal Google account? You can forward your personal account to your LEmail account so you only have to check one email.
