## Senate Resolution Number SP18 SR003

### A Resolution Supporting Increased Funding of the Computer Science Department of Lewis & Clark College

---

1 **Whereas**, the study of Computer Science (hereafter: CS), when paired with other traditional subjects  
2 such as Biology, Mathematics, and International Affairs, allows for an increasingly important  
3 interdisciplinary education incorporating modern technology,  
4

5 **Whereas**, the number of bachelor's degrees awarded nationally in CS has increased 74% since 2009,  
6 and the number of Lewis & Clark students graduating with a major in CS has increased 116% since  
7 the program began in 2009,  
8

9 **Whereas**, students enrolling in CS classes for the Spring of 2018 faced waitlists as long as 45 slots  
10 for the AI and Machine Learning course,  
11

12 **Whereas**, the number of CS professors with full-time employment has not increased since 200\_\_,  
13

14 **Whereas**, the number of credits that the CS professors are serving this semester ranges from \_\_ to  
15 \_\_ and has been increasing for the past \_\_ years,

17 **Contending that**, the CS department does not want to expand at the expense of other departments,

19 **Be it resolved by the Senate of the Associated Students here assembled**, that we recommend  
20 adding one full-time CS professor to increase the frequency and variety of courses, lower the student  
21 to professor ratio, and provide more opportunities for students to pursue independent research.

23 **Be it resolved by the Senate of the Associated Students here assembled**, that we believe that  
24 an improved CS education would place Lewis and Clark at the forefront of liberal arts education by  
25 creating a culture of integrating CS with other disciplines.
