7		The Associated Students of Lewis & Clark

9	Article	I - Purpose and Scope			
10	1.	The Auditory exists to ensure that the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark (hereafter:			
11		ASLC) and the student body can be accurately, thoroughly, and contemporarily informed on			
12		matters pertaining to the institution of Lewis & Clark College and general issues in higher			
13	2	education			
14 15	2.	These bylaws cannot be construed to contain any implied rules, powers, and abilities not			
15 16		explicitly stated			
17	Article	II - Membership			
18		The Auditory shall consist of at least one (1) member and no more than five (5) members			
19		The Auditor			
20		a. Shall manage and oversee the Auditory			
21		b. Shall serve as the chief operating officer of the Auditory and its operations			
22		c. Shall circulate, receive, and approve applications for Auditory staff members			
23		d. Shall set goals and tasks for the Auditory as not already assigned by the Senate			
24		e. Shall establish standard operating procedures for the Auditory when not stipulated			
25		within the ASLC Constitution and these Bylaws			
26	3.	Auditory Staff Members			
27		a. The Auditory may have up to four (4) staff members			
28 29		b. Staff are to be appointed at the discretion of the Auditorc. Staff shall serve as assistants to the Auditor in all matters pertaining to the office of			
30		the Auditory			
31		d. Staff shall be delegated Auditory tasks by the Auditor as the Auditor sees fit			
32		e. The following procedural guidelines shall govern the removal of a staff member by			
33		the Auditor			
34		i. The Auditor must provide said staff person with a written warning outlining			
35		performance or duty fulfilment difficulties and shortcomings			
36		ii. If said staff member's performance or behavior is found to be inadequate			
37		subsequent to a written warning, the Auditor may remove the staff member

15 16	Article	IV - Inquiries and Investigations
17		Shall be managed by the Auditor
18	2.	Shall include interviews, assessment of relevant documents, and other research, as necessary
19	3.	All inquiries and investigations, unless explicitly stated otherwise by the Auditor, shall be
20		kept confidential until the conclusion of the investigation
21	4.	The Auditory, upon approval by the Auditor, shall release the results of the investigation or
22		inquiry, steps taken, and any relevant data utilized in the investigation or inquiry
23	5.	The Senate may order an inquiry or investigation on a specified topic upon approval by a
24 25		simple majority $(>1/2)$ vote of the Senate; that topic will be given priority
25 26	Article	V - Surveys
27		The Auditor is responsible for proctoring and constructing all ASLC surveys
28		a. Although the ASLC possesses the survey data, they are neither directly responsible
29		for conducting the surveys nor limited in utilizing the data
30		b. Any third party within the college-a course, class, or other group-who wishes to
31		carry out a survey regarding or for the benefit of the ASLC, may do so
32	2.	Auditory surveys must be distributed to all undergraduate students of Lewis and Clark
33 34	2	College Each academic year the Auditory shall be responsible for maintaining distributing and
34 35	3.	Each academic year the Auditory shall be responsible for maintaining, distributing, and overseeing the following mandatory inquiries:
36		a. At least one survey concerning issues of relevance must be distributed to the student
37		body

1 2		b. An active and ongoing feedback collection system, both online and in paper, allowing for students to submit feedback at any time on any faculty member, staff
3		member, administrator or student official
4		c. An anonymous Student Senate Evaluation form shall be distributed to all Senators,
5		Representatives, Liaisons, and Cabinet Members with an allotted amount of time in
6		which the evaluation must be completed
7		i. A report on the evaluations' results will be presented to the following year's
8		cabinet and Senate
9	4.	The Senate may order the proctoring of a survey on a specified topic upon approval by a
10		simple majority $(>1/2)$ vote of the Senate; that survey will be given priority
11	5.	The Auditor should consult with relevant academic resources and faculty to assist in
12		preparing a useful survey
13	6.	These surveys shall always measure a student's concerns, grievances, or priorities for funding
14		concerning the college or ASLC
15	7.	The results of all surveys distributed by the Auditory shall be made publicly available at or
16		prior to the end of each academic year in which they were distributed
17		
18		VI - Dissemination and Availability of Information
19	1.	Upon request, the Auditor must make available the following to all members of ASLC:
20		a. Institutional data and information pertaining to the college
21		b. The results of surveys and inquiries
22	2.	Upon request, the Auditor shall provide data and information to student-run media
23		a. The request must be furnished within three days, or upon documentation and
24		recording of the requested information
25	3.	All historical records, survey results, and institutional information must be made publicly
26		available upon request, unless proscribed by State or Federal law, or college policy
27		
28		<u>VII - Monies</u>
29		The Auditor may apply for a budget from the SOC
30	2.	This budget may be used to carry out assigned duties or assumed duties
31	3.	Any member of the Auditory may propose a budget allocation to be approved by the
32	4	members of the Auditory
33		The allocation must be approved by a $2/3$ majority of committee members to be approved
34	5.	The Auditor may vote in this approval
35	A . 1	
36		<u>VIII - Amendments</u>
37	-	These bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds $(2/3)$ majority vote of the Senate
