Senate Bill Number SP19 SB013

A Bill to Amend the Elections Language in the Constitution

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark here assembled that:

Section 1: Amend Article II, Section 1, Sub-section a to read:

a. All other rules and regulations of elections shall be enumerated within the ASLC Elections Bylaws or, where appropriate or not constitutionally proscribed, delegated to the Director of Elections

Section 2: Amend Article III, Section 11 to read:

- 11. The Director of Elections shall facilitate and administer all elections of the ASLC
 - a. Shall oversee and manage the Elections Committee
 - b. Shall be nominated by the President-elect of the ASLC following the election of the following year's Cabinet and confirmed by a two-thirds (%) majority vote of the Senate no later than May 1 to serve in the following academic year
 - c. Must be a fully enrolled student at the College of Arts and Sciences to be eligible

Section 3: Amend Article III, Section 16, Sub-section b to read:

- b. The Elections Committee
 - i. Shall be overseen and managed by the Director of Elections
 - ii. Shall be composed of Associate Directors of Elections as deemed necessary by the Director of Elections, who may circulate and accept applications
 - iii. Shall oversee the implementation and effectuation of free and fair elections
 - iv. Shall enforce all elections rules and regulations
 - v. Shall operate in accordance with Article V of this Constitution and the Elections Bylaws

Section 3: Amend Article V, Section 5 to read:

5. The administrative power to facilitate and oversee elections shall be vested in the Director of Elections and their Committee

Section 4: Amend Article V, Section 5, Sub-section b to read:

b. The Director of Elections shall be nominated by the incoming President of the ASLC in concurrence with the election of the Cabinet

Section 4: Amend Article V, Section 5, Sub-section f to read:

- f. The Director of Elections shall be responsible for initiating and overseeing applications for Associate Directors
 - i. Associates are obliged to follow duties and roles set out by the Director, in line with their needs and the enumerated responsibilities of the Committee

Section 5: Amend Article V, Section 6 to read:

- 6. In the event of a Senate seat vacancy:
 - a. A Senate seat shall be considered vacant in the event:
 - i. A senator submits a formal resignation to the ASLC Senate,
 - ii. A senator is no longer taking courses at the College of Arts and Sciences,
 - iii. A senator is recalled by the student body as provided for within this Constitution,
 - b. In the event of the vacancies of one (1) or two (2) Senate seats,
 - i. The President shall notify the student body of the existence of open seats and available applications with twenty-four (24) hours unless,
 - The Elections Committee unanimously votes to extend the timeframe.
 - ii. All applications shall be submitted to the Elections Committee,
 - iii. All senators must assist the Elections Committee in circulating applications and publicizing the vacancy,
 - iv. Applicants who have submitted an application earlier in the same academic year may opt to reuse that application instead of submitting a new one,
 - Applicants shall present themselves to the Senate and will be elected by a plurality of the Senate,
 - c. In the event of the vacancies of three (3) or more Senate seats, a Special Election is the means by which these seats are filled,
 - i. The Director of Elections will initiate a special election any time:
 - 1. Three (3) or more Senate seats are vacant,
 - 2. Excepting the recall of a Senate seat, in which case a special election is automatically initiated for one (1) vacancy,
 - ii. The Director of Elections is not required to fill three (3) or more Senate seats via Special Election if both:
 - The Elections Committee (Including the Director of Elections) unanimously votes to abstain from a Special Election,
 - 2. The Senate concurs with a four-fifths (4/5) majority to abstain from a Special Election,
 - iii. In the event that a Special Election is abstained from, Elections Committee will fill the vacancies as enumerated in Article IV, subsection 1, sub-section b Introduced on <u>April 18, 2019</u> by <u>Senator Nick Gothard '21</u>
