

Senate Bill Number FA19 SB022 A Bill to Amend the ASLC Constitution to Clarify the Handling of Vacancies Within the Cabinet

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark here assembled that:

Section 1: Amend Article III, Section 13, Subsection a to read:

- a. If a Cabinet seat is vacated, the President or the Director of Elections shall send out an application for the vacated seat within one (1) week of the vacancy, and the applicants will be voted on by the Senate within three (3) Senate meetings of the application going out,
 - i. If the vacated seat is a non-elected Cabinet position, then the President shall nominate one (1) applicant for the seat who is then confirmed with a two-thirds (%) vote of the Senate,

Section 2: This bill shall take effect immediately.
