

# Senate Bill Number FA19 SB006 A Bill to Amend the Constitutional Affairs Committee Bylaws

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark here assembled that:

# Section 1: Amend Article II to read:

# <u>Article II - Membership</u>

- 1. ASLC Chief Justice
  - a. Shall act as Chair of the CAC
  - b. Shall set meeting times for the CAC
  - c. Shall set an agenda for all CAC meetings
  - d. Will vote in CAC decisions only in the case of a tie
  - e. Shall be responsible for the selection of the CAC Vice Chair
    - i. Shall be appointed by the Chief Justice from the general membership of the CAC within the first month that Senate is in session
  - f. Shall be responsible for the nomination of committee members
    - Applications for the position of committee members shall be distributed within the first month of the academic year
- 2. The CAC Vice Chair
  - a. Shall be nominated by the Chief Justice within the first month that Senate is in session and approved by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Senate
  - b. Shall assist the Chief Justice in running the CAC
  - c. Shall serve as a voting member of the CAC
    - i. Shall have one (1) vote within the CAC
  - d. Shall, in the absence or at the discretion of the Chief Justice.
    - i. Serve as Parliamentarian of the ASLC Senate
    - ii. Act as Chair of the CAC, assuming all responsibilities, powers, and restrictions
- 3. Committee Members
  - a. Shall be at least five (5) members of the CAS Student Body, including at least one (1) Senator and the CAC Vice Chair
  - b. Shall serve as voting members of the CAC
    - i. Shall have one (1) vote each
  - c. Shall perform tasks as delegated by the Chief Justice of the Committee Introduced on October 3rd, 2019 by Senator Roland Berg '22

- d. Shall attend all CAC meetings as set by the Chief Justice
  - i. Any and all absences must be reported to the Chief Justice
- e. Shall be familiar with the ASLC Constitution, all ASLC Bylaws, and all ASLC procedures
- 4. Removal of Committee Members
  - a. Voting members may be removed from CAC by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the committee

### **Section 2: Create Article VII:**

## **Article VII: Amendments**

1. These bylaws may be amended by an initial two-thirds (%) vote of the CAC followed by a two-thirds (%) vote of the ASLC Senate

Section 3: This bill shall take effect immediately.
