Auditor goals for the 2020-2021 school year.

- I. Having more data from the student body to present to ASLC because data is impartial if collected correctly, data can lead to knowledge about oppressed groups in the Lewis & Clark community. This will help us create an effective student government that will help the Lewis & Clark students.
 - A. Having a survey go out to the student body every month about different issues going on in the student body that ASLC can help with.

 - A. Over the summer I am going to be scanning documents and adding them to the auditor google drive.

B. I will be going through google drive and trying to organize all the documents that are already there.

I was able to create a completely organized google drive in order to make the auditor position effective. C. Once a month I will notify cabinet to send in documents that need to be recorded.

D. Every Senate meeting will have minutes that will be posted for all of the Lewis & Clark community to see.
