LEWIS & CLARK'S COMMITMENT TO HELPING YOU GRADUATE IN 4 YEARS

You expect to graduate in four years. And we think you should. Lewis & Clark is committed to providing you with the resources you need to meet your goal. Your advisor will meet with you each semester to go over your graduation plan. Creating and updating that plan, reviewing your Program Evaluation, and following the advice of your advisor are all critical to a successful, on-time graduation.

As you declare your major, and especially if you make additions or changes to your declared major(s)/minor(s), you are strongly encouraged to review your program evaluation and consult with your advisor(s) to be sure that you are on track to graduate on-time.

First-time freshmen entering in fall 2019 or later must do the following in order to qualify for the new official 4-Year Commitment.

- *Complete an average of 32 credits per year, remaining continuously enrolled for 8 semesters.*
 - *Consult with your advisor every semester in order to register on time for the classes you need and follow their guidance to complete your path to graduation.*
 - *Declare your major [on time](#). Changes to your academic plan may require additional coursework not covered by the 4-5-6 Commitment. Switching your major after your fourth semester may compromise your ability to graduate in four years and disqualifies you from the 4-Year Commitment.*
 - *Meet the academic and community expectations of Lewis & Clark and your major.*
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DUAL DEGREE PATHWAYS

If you are interested in pursuing one of Lewis & Clark's official dual degree pathways, you must separately submit the appropriate specialization form:

- **3-2 Engineering pathway** –In all of the 3-2 programs, the student earns one bachelor's degree from Lewis & Clark and one from the engineering school. Some of these schools also provide 4-2 options, in which the student may complete a four-year degree at Lewis & Clark and then enter a two-year program toward either a bachelor's or a master's degree in engineering.
- **3-3 Law pathway** – Lewis & Clark Law School partners with the College of Arts and Sciences to offer an accelerated joint-degree program that allows students to earn both a BA and JD degree in just six years, compared with the usual seven.
