Please note: Part A and Part B are both due by the application due date.

Part A

Application (including essay responses)

Information needed to complete application:

- Passport Information
- Parent/Guardian Information
- Emergency Contact Information
- Academic Information (student ID, GPA, major, language(s) studied)

Passport Photo - please read through <u>this article</u> for guidance on taking a passport photo, and make sure that your photo meets these State Department <u>requirements</u>. You can download an app, such as Passport Photo Booth (<u>iOs</u> and <u>Android</u>), or you can use the 'Square' mode on your phone. The US Department of State also has a <u>photo cropping tool</u> to resize your photo to the correct dimensions. You will submit the passport photo by uploading it to the last page of your application.

Two Academic References (contact 3-4 weeks prior to application deadline)

Part B

After submitting your application, please follow these instructions for submitting your remaining application materials.

- Unofficial Transcript
 - Students can download their unofficial transcripts for free in WebAdvisor.
 - The unofficial transcript should be submitted via email to overseas@lclark.edu.
 - *First-Year/Transfer Students:* Submit your current course enrollment as found in <u>WebAdvisor</u>. Transfer students may submit an unofficial transcript from their previous institution.
- Advisor Approval Form
 - Please complete the form digitally, and make an appointment with your Faculty or College Advisor to discuss how the program aligns with your academic goals at Lewis & Clark.
 - You should sign the form using the digital signature function of Adobe Reader (download it for free here).
 - Once your Advisor has digitally signed your form, submit the PDF via email to overseas@lclark.edu.
