On-Campus Flu Vaccine Clinic, Oct. 13**

Lewis & Clark's Health Service is offering an on-campus clinic on Thursday, October 13 in the Agnes Flanagan Chapel.

To participate in the clinics, our outside vendor is requiring that you must either:

1. [Complete your insurance form](#) and bring it with you to your appointment
2. Pay \$35 at the clinic (cash or check) to cover the cost of the vaccination.

**Advance sign-ups are required for these clinics.** If you would like to participate in the clinics, please sign up as soon as possible. **It is very important that you bring your completed insurance and consent form with you to the clinic.**

If you desire flu vaccination, but the above criteria are barriers for you, please e-mail [health@lclark.edu](mailto:health@lclark.edu) for guidance about other possible ways to receive flu vaccine. *As a reminder, our on-campus flu clinics are only for seasonal influenza vaccine, not for COVID vaccine.*

**What about the new Covid Bivalent Booster?**

We don't have the new bivalent COVID vaccine in supply on campus yet. We are hoping to have it soon, but your best bet for getting it ASAP is to schedule it at your local pharmacy.

The new bivalent COVID booster is safe and effective and can be given at the same time as the flu shot. It protects against the original strain and the Omicron variants BA.4 and BA.5. You can get either the Pfizer or Moderna COVID vaccine two months after any initial vaccine series or two months after a previous booster. There is no cost for the Covid vaccine booster.
