## Parents: Important Financial Aid Information

Greetings from the Financial Aid Office,

It may seem a bit early to be thinking about next year, but we wanted to let you know about the process to reapply for financial aid for the 2023-24 year.

### Important Notes:

- If your student receives only a merit-based scholarship award and if this is the only form of financial aid you wish to receive for 2023-24, you do not need to submit the FAFSA.

### Helpful Hints:

- Reapply for financial aid for the 2023-2024 year by submitting the [2023-24 FAFSA](#) prior to February 15, 2023.
- If presented the choice, import your 2021 income information into the FAFSA directly from the IRS using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. This tool can make the FAFSA filing process easier and more accurate.
- In divorced family situations, only the custodial parent (plus that parent's spouse, if applicable) should file the FAFSA.
- If a recent change has significantly reduced your family's income, please visit [go.lclark.edu/changes](https://go.lclark.edu/changes).
