1. Review last week's [minutes](#): vote to approve
  - **Minutes unanimously approved**
2. An official welcome to our newest member of the Senate: Julia Thompson!
3. Feb. BOT update
  - a. Here is the [summary](#) that M3 has created to send out to the student body
    - **They are starting a new fundraising project next year that will hopefully get more money to institutionalize College Outdoors scholarships and get the school to pay for symposia**
4. Moving back to our [Legislative Agenda](#): We have some new bills to propose and discuss and (hopefully) vote on!
  - a. [SB003](#) (Honoraria Increase for ASB members across the board)
    - **Bill has been changed to give the notetaker \$1,000 instead of \$500 (#real) and HWC Chair will get \$3,000 instead of \$2,000**
    - **Finn says this needs to be passed by 3/9, summary needs to be worked on**
    - **M3's qualms: it is not in complete paragraph form, the first paragraph should have a concluding sentence. The second paragraph should rationalize why we decided the numbers, we made 2 main changes (increasing HWC chair and notetaker honoraria), these are not represented in the summary.**
    - **SFV says something to add is that we want honoraria to reflect the amount of work students put in, Finn edits the document**
    - **SFV makes a Google Doc so Senators/ reps can make edits to the bill summary**
    - **Various changes are made to the bill: adding to the second paragraph to represent the rationalizations for the bill and the changes made to the bill, adding a conclusion sentence to the first paragraph,**
    - **SFV clarifies that if passed, this bill will go into effect next year**

- The student fee goal for next year is \$625,000, FIN allocates conservatively because we do not know how many students will be incoming next year
  - The last few years, we have had more incoming students than we have expected, so we do not expect the student fee to go down in the pool
  - The student fee stays at a stable \$360 no matter how many students commit to LC
  - Rocky says he thinks this is very reasonable, will help participation and in recognizing the service student government does on campus
  - Destiny motions to vote, Helena seconds
  - Yes: 14
  - No: 0
  - Abstain: 0
  - Bill passes unanimously!! Major slay!
- b. [SB004](#) (establishing a (bi-)monthly Senate meeting)
- i. This bill needs some work so let's discuss!
- Option 1: meet weeks 1 and 4, weeks 2 and 3 off
  - Option 2: meet weeks 1 and 3, weeks 2 and 4 off
  - Option 3: meet weeks 2 and 4, weeks 1 and 3 off
  - Option 2 would mean we meet right after the election, the first meeting would be a long training and the second meeting would be the first legislative session
  - Straw poll:

  - Conclusion: we've established that we want to do bimonthly meetings rather than monthly, but we haven't decided what specifically we want to do
  - Yonas still feels like this is not enough time to get everything done, SFV and other Senators disagree and say we have already come to the general consensus that we want to do bimonthly meetings
  - Yonas suggests that if people feel we could be more efficient with Senate sessions (as we would need to be with bimonthly meetings), we should try to do it now and see if we are capable
