In order to qualify for this stipend, we ask you to indicate a proposed project and to describe your research plans. We encourage you to put these funds to good use! They might be used this summer or at any time thereafter in conjunction with a senior project or thesis later in your career. You also might use them in conjunction with an overseas trip, a journey to an archive, equipment for conducting interviews, etc. You are first eligible to receive these funds in the summer following the successful completion of your fourth semester, but you may apply at any time thereafter. One caveat: These funds must be used, and the project completed, before your graduation from Lewis & Clark College.

Please describe your research proposal, indicating the question that you plan to ask, your plans for developing an answer, and the location in which you expect to conduct this research. Please also indicate your proposed outcome and prepare a budget, indicating how these funds will be used.

Please attach your narrative to this form; have it signed by your advisor and submit the packet to Debbie Richman in the Office of the Dean of the College, Albany 201, who will issue the check once grades have been submitted. *N.B. This may be taxable income*.
