Chris Ohman '77 –President's Report

Board of Trustees meeting recap from May

- Construction progress: Templeton's transformation is now complete and is renamed the Fowler Student Center after our now former Trustee chair Stephanie Fowler. The student center feels more like the heart of the campus with Stewart Odell renovations enhancing the connection to the new spaces.
- Comprehensive Campaign: As of May 1, there is 7 Million to raise to reach the 155 Million goal. The first campaign in twenty years is shaping up to be a success and Robin has begun preparing her own strategy and vision for the next campaign to follow. More on this when Josh and Julie gives their updates.
- New VP of Communications: Lori Friedman is an exciting addition to the LC Communications team. Her experience as a strategic communications and media relations specialist will help spread the word about all the great things LC is doing and stands for.
- New CAS Faculty hiring in the following departments: Economics, Mathematics, Theater, Biology, Physics, Ceramics, and Biochemistry.
- Fulbright Scholarships: Lewis & Clark continues to be one of the top producers of Fulbright award winners in the country, demonstrating a sustained commitment to international education and engagement.
- Enrollment: CAS may not hit our budget goal for new applications but the plan is to have an incoming class that is at or slightly lower than last fall but still at a historical high. Grad School is experiencing lower demand for Masters in Teaching but is continuing to have a strong interest in the counseling programs. Law school is undertaking multiple construction projects across campus this summer. A classroom is turning into a teaching courtroom and the Boley Law Library will undergo a much-needed remodel. Applications are down but the quality of LSAT scores and GPA is continuing an eight-year trend upwards and for the budget goal still looking good.

Administrative Committee - Peter Dempsey '01

■ Board of Alumni Elections

We have six positions to fill during this 2023 cycle. Three are the open positions because of members cycling off or have resigned (Catherine Gibson, Aron Phillips, and Peter Dempsey). Three incumbents (Jen Cyphers, Marisol Jenkins, and Jessica Mullins) have chosen to be on the ballot and if elected will serve a second term.

■ Bylaws

The Admin Committee has undertaken a review of the Board of Alumni bylaws and has proposed the adoption of a 'Housekeeping Provision' designed to allow the Administrative Committee to make non-substantive modifications to the bylaws document without having to go through the formal process of a full Board vote.

57% Gifts received: 25% Bequest Intentions, 10% Pledges yet to receive, and 8% Trusts & Annuities.

The advancement office now has a new staff position dedicated to athletics fundraising. Doug Lenox, *Athletics Advancement Officer*, joined our team in May 2023.

Annual Giving metrics—Julie Newsome, *Director of Donor Engagement* Julie shares *Econometrics of why alumni give* via/screen presentation

Alex Denuzzo '25 our Data Intern conducted some research using econometric techniques to analyze what characteristics make someone more likely to donate. Econometrics is a branch of economics that applies statistical methods, mathematics, and economic theory to analyze and quantify economic relationships and make predictions or forecasts.

One thing we found out from this research is that being a volunteer was the top way to get someone to become more likely to be a donor. The second most likely way to get someone to become more likely to give was if someone attended an LC event.
