Wednesday, November 8 11am-1pm IME Suite - pop in!


Please join the IME suite in celebrating First Generation Celebration Day. We will have donuts and juice for First-Gen students to pop in and hang out throughout the day.

This event is for those who identify as Latino/a/e/x!




All Community Prayer Vigil for Peace



The Asian Studies program is excited to invite you to our annual Meet Your Major Gathering. Come meet the amazing faculty in the program and learn about the major and minor.


Directly following the gathering, Sidra Kamran will be showing the movie "Offside" as part of the Asian Studies film series.
