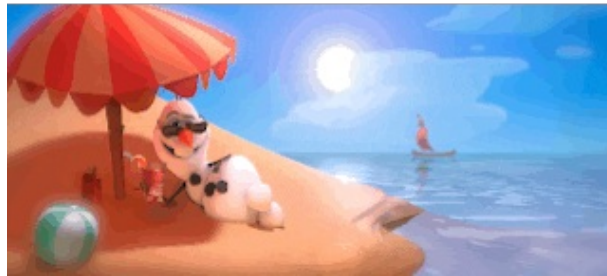




Week 4: Happy Black History Month!

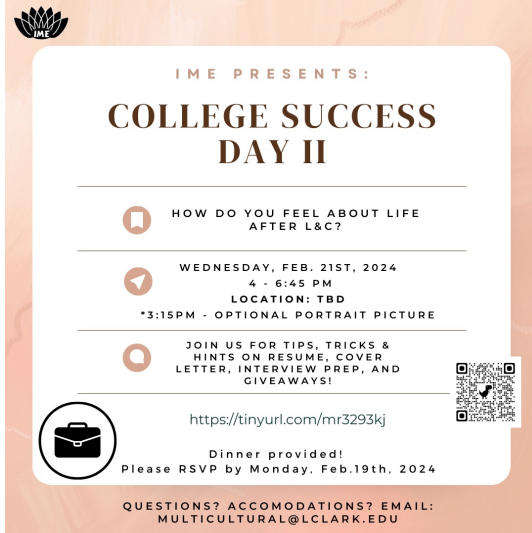

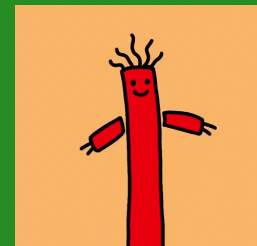
LGBTQ+ Drop-In Office Hours

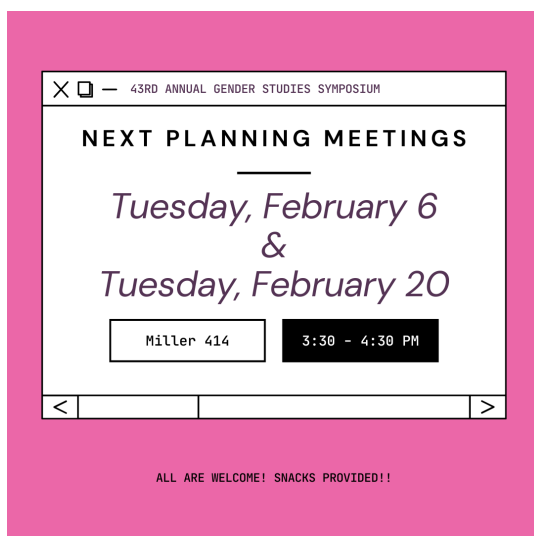
Please submit your work through the linked Google form by **February 12, 2024**.
