# Nuts and Bolts

## Pricing

If you are planning to stay off campus for Reunion Weekend, the cost of your entire reunion, including the class reception, special reunion meal, all-class Northwest barbecue, meals in Fields, overseas or off-campus program reunion, Alumni College, and other campus activities is \$65 per person. The cost for children ages 5 to 17 is only \$35 for the weekend. Children ages 4 and younger can attend for \$10 for the weekend.

Staying on campus is very affordable as well. Adults can stay in residence halls for about an additional \$30 per day, children 5 to 17 for an additional \$19 per day, and children 4 and younger for free.

Special family rates allow a family of four (two adults and two children ages 5 to 17) to enjoy accommodations, meals, and all reunion weekend activities for an average cost of \$125 per day; the price is even lower if one or both of the children is 4 or younger.

## On-Campus Housing

You can reserve your housing when you register at [go.lclark.edu/college/reunions/registration](http://go.lclark.edu/college/reunions/registration). We will place you next to your classmates in residence halls and you will receive your building and room confirmation prior to your arrival on campus.

The deadline to reserve on-campus housing is May 27, 2010.

There are two types of housing available on campus: residence halls and apartments.

- Residence halls feature a shared sleeping space with twin beds for two to four people and a shared bathroom for each floor. Rooms are available for individuals and groups.
- Apartments feature private bedrooms with twin beds and a shared bathroom, kitchen, and living area for each apartment. Apartments are available for groups of two or more.

Both types of housing include common lounge areas where you can relax and spend time with friends.

There are no age restrictions for staying on campus. However, we are unable to provide any special equipment, such as cribs, and it is the parents' responsibility to supervise their children while staying on campus.

## Off-Campus Housing

Hilton Portland & Executive Tower, located blocks away from Pioneer Courthouse Square, is pleased to offer a special discounted rate of \$89 per night for Reunion guests. A block of rooms has been reserved especially for that weekend and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. The Hilton is conveniently located blocks away from Pioneer Square, where you can catch the shuttle to campus and the MAX train to and from the airport. ## Transportation and Parking

From the airport, take the MAX light rail (red line) to Pioneer Courthouse Square. A free Reunion shuttle will run between Pioneer Square and Lewis & Clark from June 24 to June 27. The shuttle is not equipped with a luggage bay, but you can bring your luggage on board.

From Pioneer Courthouse Square, you can easily access much of Portland by public transit and walking. So use the Reunion shuttle to explore the city!

If you drive to campus, you are welcome to park your car on campus for the duration of Reunion Weekend free of charge.
